

Work Based Learning (WBL) at the University of Cumbria

How to Gain Academic Credit for Endoscopy Study Days

**20 or 40 credits at Diploma, Degree and Masters Level
[£215 per 20 credit module]**

The purpose of WBL is to support effective learning and development and the application of knowledge and skills within the practice situation

After attending the study day, you can use the opportunity to build your learning into an academic module. You will complete a WBL proposal form, which identifies your personal learning outcomes and details the activities that you will undertake to evidence your development. You will need a clinical facilitator and the approval of your manager.

You may choose to develop specific clinical competencies, selected from Skills for Health or you may wish to develop other competencies which are appropriate for you.

You can also link your WBL proposal to the Knowledge and Skills Framework, in this way your learning within the WBL module will be related directly to your post outline.

The University of Cumbria accredits the TECNA course for 20-40 academic credits (at Diploma, Degree and Masters Level) through completion of the work based learning (WBL) module. The credits gained from this module can be used towards a Diploma, University Advanced Diploma, Degree or Masters qualification.
